

Wayne County Public Library Computer Policy

Wayne County Public Library provides free access to the Internet. We also provide free WiFi on an open, unsecured network. We are not responsible for any content accessed via our computers or WiFi.

- Patrons with a valid library card are allowed up to one hour of use per day. An out-of-county resident, with a valid government issued photo ID, may be issued a guest pass.
- Do not use library computers or WiFi for any illegal activity. Computer, device, and WiFi users must abide by our expectations of behavior.
- All devices must be used in a responsible manner, respecting the rights of other users.
- Users may not make any attempt to damage, alter or override computer equipment or software. Computer and internet settings may not be changed. Users may not invade the privacy of others or engage in any activity that is harassing or defamatory.

Violation of this policy may result in revocation of utilization privileges and/or immediate termination of the violator's relationship with the Wayne County Public Library.
