

# Introduction to: The History of Wayne County by Judge Frank A. Daniels

This index was originally written on index cards for the Wayne County Public Library in Goldsboro, NC. The creator is unknown. The data entry for the document was completed by library volunteers in August, 2004.

*The History of Wayne County* was written by Judge Frank A. Daniels. It was given as a speech at the dedication of the Wayne County Courthouse on November 30, 1914. His speech begins with the mid 1700s and continues into the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. Topics include the organization of Wayne, Dobbs and Johnston counties; Wayne County citizens, officials, businesses, agriculture, transportation, schools, newspapers, churches, government and its first court; the Revolutionary War and the Civil War; and many others.
